For this purpose, we commit oursleves:

- To monitor and reduce our energy consumption
- To monitor and reduce our water consumption
- To guarantee a healthy atmosphere, using health-friendly cleaning products

It is in this context that we have been labeled a "Clef Vert" ("Green Key") establishment., the first sustainable tourism label, developed by the association "Teragir" which will support us in our efforts.

The label is intended to promote accommodation structures and restaurants committed to a voluntary environmental approach.

The label is awarded each year by a jury made up of experts and professionals in tourism and environment. It certifies the conformity of establishments with respect to a certain number of criteria.
